Tijuca forest national park, passing by the Açude da Solidão which is a secondary entrance to the forest passing by to the Emperor's Table. Returning to the jeeps, another stop now at the famous Tijuca Waterfall, Cascatinha falls

No-one will believe that they are in the middle of a "jungle" in Rio de Janeiro! Then transfer until the Paineiras station where they will board on the van with 10 seats to go up to the Statue of Christ Redeemer in the top of Corcovado Mountain. After time to enjoy the view and take Photos, return to Paineiras in vans and embark in the jeeps. Lunch at local restaurant.



Metropolitan Cathedral - Rio De Janeiro

After lunch, now in a Minibus, visit the Botanical Garden is 137 hectares and has vegetation similar to the Atlantic Forest. The arboretum, to which the visitors have access, counts 54 hectares. With 7200 species of plants classified, including roughly 5500 trees and shrubs, it is considered one of the most important botanical gardens in the world. The first greenhouse at the Rio de Janeiro Botanical Gardens was built in 1890. It was made out of wood and shaped as an octagon. In the 1930's, the greenhouse was remodeled in glass and iron, similar to the style of the English glasshouses. Today the Orchidarium includes the glasshouse and the whole area that surrounds it, with a nursery with over 3000 orchid vases.

After visits, transfer to the hotel.

RIO BY NIGHT: DINNER BARBECUE & SAMBA SHOW AT GINGA TROPICAL - duration 5 hours

HALF DAY SUGAR LOAF WITH LUNCH

Via the Aterro do Flamengo, you will be taken to the neighborhood of Urca where one of the largest symbols of the city is located: Sugar Loaf. You will travel all the way to the top in two steps by cable car. The first cable car

takes us to Urca Hill, a vantage points 215 meters high for which already grants beautiful views of Guanabara Bay and its islands, the Rio-Niterói Bridge and Corcovado Mountain. From this stage, a second cable car takes us up to the top. At 395 meters we will enjoy splendid views of Copacabana beach, the Santa Cruz fortress and several beaches of Niterói. Dinner at local Indian restaurant.

DAY 04 Buffet breakfast.
At the scheduled time, transfer to the airport. Upon arrival, transfer to for your tour. Lunch at local restaurant.

HALF DAY BRAZILIAN FALLS

Located in front of hotel Belmond Cataratas, the tour follows with a walking time through the most important track of the park where the participants could enjoy an astonishing view of the waterfalls. From the local belvedere the participants will have a privileged sight of the both parks of the waterfalls, Return to the main point via the panoramic elevator. Dinner at local restaurant.

DAY 05 Buffet breakfast.
FULL DAY ARGENTINEAN SIDE OF THE FALLS

Departure from the hotel to Iguazú National Park - a total of 55,500 hectares - bears the name of the river serving as northern border, which means 'great waters' in the guaraní language. Surrounded by a lush subtropical rainforest, we will find the majestic Iguazú Waterfalls. Its water volume and more than 275 falls places it among the most important and spectacular waterfalls in the world. On different footbridges, we will visit the heart of the waterfalls, appreciating them from different angles. We will visit the lower circuit, and

feel part of nature, refreshing ourselves with waterfall drizzle. On the upper circuit, we will stop at different viewpoints, and then reach the balcony at Gargantadel Diablo (Devil's Throat). No doubt, this is the most amazing of all falls: water falls down from 80 meters. Lunch at local restaurant.

BIG ADVENTURE NAVIGATION TOUR (ARGENTINEAN SIDE)

A tour that combines rainforest and waterfalls. We will drive trucks into the vast wild vegetation joined by experimented guides. We will get off at the pier and board a boat to sail the Iguazú Inferior river canyon, rafting the river rapids to appreciate falls from the San Martín island peaceful backwater. Then we will visit the TresMosqueteros (Three Musketeers) fall, and Gargantadel Diablo (Devil's Throat) will crown the tour. Sailing the coast of the island, we will get to the next exciting point: the San Martín fall, the greatest a boat can approach.

IMPORTANT: We recommend taking a second pair of shoes, informal clothes in order to change because in the Great Adventure excursion everyone will get wet.

Certain visitors are not allowed to ride: Great Adventure or Nautical Adventure navigation:

In this most complete overview of the Paris of South America we will visit the glamorous neighborhoods of Recoleta and its most famous cemetery, Palermo, May Square and the Pink House, the Metropolitan Cathedral, the newest & trendiest Puerto Madero Area and many other emblematic buildings and palaces of unique architectural, historical, and cultural value. The visit would not be complete without the

sights of the first settlements of the city of Buenos Aires. The pintoresque neighborhood of San Telmo, residence to the porteño aristocracy until the end of the XIX century and where the renowned antiques market is held every Sunday; Caminito Street, in the colorful, Italian immigrants neighborhood of La Boca.

07 Highlights: San Isidro Cathedral - Tigre Navigation

This tour will offer the passengers a different way to explore and enjoy the nature, very close to the city. On the way north to Tigre, which is about 30 km away from Buenos Aires, and one of the biggest Deltas in the world, you will go through one of the most beautiful accesses downtown, passing by residential suburban neighbourhoods with their calm narrow roads, Yacht clubs, and mansions. Departing from Tigre's pier, on board of a typical island launch, the green labyrinth of channels and streams will open its doors to let you explore the nature of its islands, enjoying the views of beautiful riverside villas, Victorian docks, English gardens, and traditional rowing and boating clubs. For more that 100 years, the maze of rivers and channels of the Tigre Delta have been a favourite weekend gateway for "porteños". During this relaxing off-site, you will leave the bustling city behind and enter a world that has changed little since the 1920s.

Then, discover the San Francisco Monastery, one of the most spectacular churches of colonial Lima. Visit its catacombs and a very fine museum of religious art from the XVII century. The tour goes all the way to the modern district of San Isidro, where you will appreciate HuacaHuallamarca, a pre Incan pyramid made out of adobe, and finish in the touristic district of Miraflores, where you will observe the Pacific Ocean coast from the vast seafloor.

09 Half Day City + Archaeological Sites

Visit to the city of Cusco, also called the Imperial City, and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The excursion starts at Koricancha temple, an ancient Inca palace and centre of worship of the sun god, on the site of which the Dominicans ordered a church to be built, which survives to this day. Then to the Main Square, where you will visit the cathedral, the most

important religious building in the city. The climb continues to Sacsayhuamán fortress, an impressive example of Inca military architecture. Then to Kenko, where the sun, moon and stars were worshipped. Next: a visit to Puca-Pucara, which may have been a "tambo" or rest and lodging place for the Inca. Finally, a visit to the Inka's Expression art workshop, where you will be able to see artists working in silver, paint and wood -the perfect place to see Andean art. Lunch at local restaurant.

NOTE

Cuzco is well above 11,000 feet some passengers traveling from lower elevations may experience symptoms of altitude sickness, known within the Andes as Sorocho. DAY **01** **Arrive Puerto Maldonado**

After breakfast, Proceed ON YOUR OWN to the airport for your flight to Puerto Maldonado.

On arrival in Puerto Maldonado transfer to the Lodge.

Welcome in Puerto Maldonado, Begin to experience the enchantment of the rainforest, as you take a 45-minute boat ride along the Madre de Dios River to arrive at InkaterraReservaAmazonicalodge. After a short briefing, settle into your beautiful cabaña and enjoy your lunch in the dining room. Take a siesta, share a refreshing tea time. Its leisure time in case if you are not taking any afternoon excursion. you can choose from the 14 different excursions available at the Inkaterra lodge by paying additional cost. Enjoy the dinner, served in the main dining room from 7:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. After dinner, you may retire early to your own cabaña, or join us to talk about the experience of life in the rainforest, as you listen to the intriguing sounds of the jungle at night.

Overnight at InkaterraReservaAmazonica or similar in Puerto Maldonado. (LL, LD)

DAY **02** **Visit Lake Sandoval. Visit the remarkable Inkaterra Canopy Walkway and Anaconda Walk**

Today after breakfast visit the Lake Sandoval excursion into the Tambopata National Reserve. Glide in a wooden canoe, across a beautiful, mirror-like oxbow lake that is home to the endangered giant river otter, as well as red howler monkeys, red-bellied macaws, anacondas, side-neck turtles and black caimans. Return to Inkaterra lodge for lunch. After lunch, proceed to visit the remarkable Inkaterra Canopy Walkway and Anaconda Walk. Ascending the first tower 29 meters above the forest ground, you begin your

encounter with the treetop realm. For more than a quarter of a mile, you will literally walk through the rainforest canopy on a suspension bridge network linking eight observation platforms. During this hour-and-a-half expedition be on the lookout for bright toucans, woodpeckers, trogons, monkeys and the three-toed sloth. If you wish you may extend your excursion and appreciate the sunset from one of the towers. After your descent from the Canopy, experience the Anaconda Walk for about 30 minutes along the 200-meter wooden bridge

DAY **03** over the Aguajales swamps. In this lush eco system, you may observe the various species of amphibians, birds, mammals, abundant flora, trees and there is a possibility to see serpents of this flooded marshland. The walk finishes by returning to the lodge.

Once at the lodge, enjoy the daily nature presentation in the Eco Center.

Tonight enjoy dinner at the lodge.

Overnight at InkaterraReservaAmazonica or similar in Puerto Maldonado. (B, LL, LD)

Farewell!!!

After breakfast depart for a boat trip on the Madre de Dios River which takes you to Puerto Maldonado, where you may visit Inkaterra Butterfly House. Peru boasts the greatest variety of butterflies in the world, with 3,700 known species. Many of these can be seen at the Butterfly House, a showcase for the variety, beauty and adaptability of these fascinating insects.
