03 **Great Wall- Olympic Park & Jade Factory**
After breakfast, in the morning drive 75km to visit the Jade factory and Great Wall at Juyong pass, which is the symbol of China and the wisdom of Chinese people. It is very unbelievable that Chinese succeeded in building such a great architecture with simple tools in ancient time. You continue your trip to Summer Palace. Having the largest royal park and being well preserved,

02 **Tiananmen Square – Forbidden City & Lama Temple**
After breakfast, depart from hotel in the morning to visit the biggest public square in the world; Tiananmen Square conquers you with its grandeur at the first sight. Then you are led to Forbidden City. It is the imperial palace for 24 emperors during Ming and Qing dynasties and the biggest ancient architecture complex in the world. You walk in the museum to see with your eyes, to touch with your hands and feel with your hearts. In the afternoon, you continue your trip to Lama Temple, which architectural styles are unique in the fact that it combines Manchurian, Chinese, Tibetan, and Mongolian aspects. Everywhere a visitor turns, expansive details and bold patterns can be found to tease and tantalize the senses.
Evening you will enjoy the Acrobatic show at Chaoyang Theatre.

it was designated, in 1960 by the State Council, as a Key Cultural Relics Protection Site of China. Containing examples of the ancient arts, it also has graceful landscapes and magnificent constructions. After sightseeing, you will visit the Pearl Factory; you will have a short stop and take photos in Beijing Olympic Park, where you can see the outside view of the National Stadium-- Bird's Nest and National Aquatics Centre --Water Cube. Tea house will be followed after the sightseeing.

04 **Beijing -Xian Pagoda, Bell & Drum Tower (by high speed bullet train. Train cost included.)**

05 **Xian – Zhangjiajie (by flight). Visit the Terracotta Warriors & Meitao Factory**
Breakfast at hotel, then depart for a Full day tour with a visit to the China's Richest historic area, which is recognized by the UNESCO as the eighth wonder of the world, amazing Museum of the Terra Cotta Warriors which is very famous for the great underground army of the First Emperor of China, buried together with him 2200 years ago and discovered only in 1974. It is the most significant archaeological excavations of the 20th century.
Take evening flight to Zhangjiajie (flight cost included). Arrive at DYG Airport, transfer to your hotel & check in hotel. ZhangJiaJie National Forest Park is the first established National Forest Park in China. It is famous for its large area of quartz sandstone physiognomy. It is of great natural aesthetic value and therefore selected as World Natural Heritage and World Geological Park by UNESCO.
Overnight at hotel Pullman / Crowne Plaza or similar in Zhagjiajie. (B, LL, PD)

06 **National Forest Park, Yuanjiajie, Mt. Tianzishan**
After breakfast, take the Bailong Lift to the core of Zhangjiajie World Natural Heritage, Yuanjiajie is a mysterious, magic and primitive place. It is the only special conservation area among all World Natural Heritages of China. Within the resort, when clouds and mists rise, you may feel standing at a fairyland. The peak scenes, Avatar mountain, resembling columns, scourges, towers, human, birds and animals, can bring you beautiful illusions. Visit Mt. Tianzishan Nature Reserve: Helong Park, West-sea Stone Forest and etc., down the mountain by cable car.
Overnight at hotel Pullman / Crowne Plaza or similar in Zhagjiajie. (B, LL, LD)

07 **Zhangjiajie – Shanghai (by flight). Zhangjiajie Grand Canyon, transparency glass bridge, National Art Gallery, Zhangjiajie**
After breakfast, proceed to Zhangjiajie Grand Canyon Scenic area covers an area of about 60 square kms,15kms away from Wulingyuan Scenic area -- the world natural heritage. The Grand Canyon known as the world's longest and highest glass-bottomed bridge in the world, which is 430-meter-long, six-meter-wide and 300 meters above the valley floor. It will be the world's longest glass bridge without the use of any reinforced concrete. Designed by architect Haim Dotan, the bridge deck is wholly paved with transparent glass and can carry 800 people. Built among high mountains and canyon, it also has a bungee platform in the center. National Art Gallery --JunSheng Sandstone Painting Gallery with impressive 3 dimensions, the Sandstone Painting merged with arts of traditional Chinese Painting. Proceed to airport for the flight to Shanghai.

DAY 08 Shanghai - Jade Buddha Temple - Yuyuan Garden - Maglev Train

After breakfast, you will visit a Buddhism shrine - Jade Buddha Temple, located in a crowd of Shanghai City. It is named for its two bejeweled white jade Buddha. Carved from a whole piece of white jade, the sitting jade Buddha statue is translucent with a solemn expression, displaying the excellent skill and extraordinary art of Chinese people. Yuyuan Garden has many scenic courtyards decorated with baroque rockery, pools, and flora that are all connected by corridors and passageways. Later enjoy the Maglev train ride.

DAY 09 Zhujiajiao – TV Tower – Bund - Shopping

After breakfast, today you will visit Zhujiajiao; Located in a suburb of Shanghai city, Zhujiajiao is an ancient water town well-known throughout the country, with a history of more than 1700 years. Covering an area of 47 square kilometres, the little fan-shaped town glimmers like a bright pearl in the landscape of lakes and mountains. Endowed with another elegant name - 'Pearl Stream' - the little town is the best-preserved among the four ancient towns in Shanghai. After a wonderful trip today, you drive back to Shanghai, shopping at the Bund, Nanjing road and TV Tower, which was completed on October 1, 1994. The tower has a height of 468 meters. With multi-functions of sightseeing, catering, shopping, amusement and accommodations, this tower has become the symbol of the city and a popular tourist attraction in Shanghai.
